

## Important Notes Regarding the Access to the Event Site

Ninomiya station and Oiso station are the closest train stations to the event site. Platforms and ticket gates areas of these stations are not very big, so if all the participants come at the same time, these stations will inevitably be overcrowded. Therefore, it is advised to refer to the section on “nearest stations and recommended arrival time.”

**Important Note: Please DO NOT drive or have your family or friend drive you to the event to prevent traffic congestion.**

<p>① Train</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- In order to alleviate congestions at Ninomiya station and Oiso station, alternate stations are listed on the enclosed note. However, if advised by the train operator to get off at another station, please follow their advice.</li> <li>- Full marathon participants are advised to arrive at Ninomiya station or Oiso station by <b>7:10</b>, and 10K participant by <b>8:10</b>. Arriving later than these times may result in not making it to the start line in time.</li> <li>- As for times listed as “high” on Table 1, it is expected that these stations will be experiencing major congestion. Please consider arriving at times listed as “low.”</li> <li>- Please remember that not all the passengers on trains on the race day are this event’s participants. Please be mindful for others, and give up your seat for elderly or physically challenged. Thank you in advance for your kindness.</li> <li>- Tokaido Line will offer additional train services on the race day, for details, please refer to the event’s official website or JR’s timetable.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Please use prepaid card (Suica or PASMO) to avoid congestion at the ticket vending machines area.</li> <li>- There is only one fare-adjusting machine at Ninomiya Station and at Oiso Station. <b>Please make sure that your prepaid card has enough money charged for round trip in advance.</b></li> </ul>
<p>② Bus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Free shuttle busses will operate on the race day. <b>Shuttle Bus Stop 1: To Oiso Port (only return service from the event site)</b> <b>Shuttle Bus Stop 2: To and from Oiso Station / to and from Ninomiya Station</b></li> <li>- Busses will be servicing on a timely basis (It takes about 10 minutes from Oiso Port to Oiso Station by walk.)</li> <li>- As for locations of these shuttle bus stops, please refer to the event site map.</li> <li>- There will be paid direct bus services to the event site from Shinjuku, Omiya, Chiba, Yokohama, Machida, Ebina, Ofuna, etc. Bus tickets must be reserved in advance. For details, please refer to the event’s official website.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Shuttle Bus Stop 1: Parking Lot #3</li> <li>- Shuttle Bus Stop 2: Oiso Prince Hotel Main Entrance</li> </ul>

<p>③ Taxi</p>	<p>- Due to road closures, there will be designated drop-off locations for participants arriving to the event by taxi. Please note that <b>taxis are not allowed to access to the event site.</b></p>	<p>- Designated Taxi Drop-Off Locations          ◎ Passengers Arriving from Hiratsuka/Oiso: <b>Shiroyama Koen Park Parking Lot</b>          ◎ Passengers Arriving from Kozu/Ninomiya: <b>on Route 1 or further out.</b>          - On the event day, you will be dropped off at either of these locations If you tell a taxi driver to go to the event site due to road closures. Thank you in advance for your understanding.</p>
<p>④ Car / Motorcycle / Bicycle</p>	<p>- <b>Please DO NOT drive or have your family or friend drive you to the event.</b>          - On the race day, vehicles without permit will not be allowed to stop or park on road near the event site. Some sections of roads will be closed completely. Also, there is no parking available near the event.          - If you arrive to the event site by bicycle, please use the designated location to keep your bike. Please note that the space is limited, so it is advised to use the public transportation if possible.          - For details, please refer to the map on the back side.</p>	<p>- There is no parking near the event site. At previous events, traffic congestions were caused by participants who came to the event by car.  <b>- Coming to the event by car may result in disqualification or ban from future events. Thank you in advance for your understanding.</b></p>
<p>⑤ Spectators</p>	<p>- Spectators are asked to arrive at Ninomiya station or Oiso station no earlier than 8:30. (The event site will open for participants at 6:45.)</p>	<p>- <b>Spectators may not be allowed in the event site before 9:00.</b> Recommended family/friend meet-up location is the rest area.</p>
<p>⑥ Other Important Note</p>	<p>- On a crowded train or bus, please carry your backpack in your hand to allow as many people as possible on board.          - Participants who walk to the event site from Ninomiya station or Oiso station are asked to be mindful for the neighborhood residents and refrain from speaking loudly.          - For your own safety, please follow traffic laws and use pedestrian crossing to cross streets.</p>	


